Recovery Houses

provide more than space, beds, dining areas, and rules and regulations for maintaining the residence:

RH engage people in a process of change to help improve health and wellness.

RH help people gain the courage to self-direct their lives.

RH help people find and strive for their full potential.

RH create environments where residents are most likely to achieve recovery.

RH promote the idea of community and positive social interactions.

RH provide peer support.



Guiding Principles

- Recovery is possible and sustainable.
- Recovery is different for every individual.
- Immediate access to recovery resources should be available to every Missourian, regardless of ability to pay.
- Long-term relationships help support people in recovery.



Ensuring quality recovery housing begins with quality standards. The Missouri Coalition of Recovery Support Providers (MCRSP) accredits recovery residences throughout the state of Missouri based on standards established by the National Alliance for Recovery Residences (NARR). MCRSP also collaborates with the MO Department of Mental Health (DMH), through the State Opioid Response Grant (SOR) to assist recovery homes in becoming accepting of medications for addiction treatment (MAT) and trained in overdose response and naloxone administration.

> **SOR-funded houses in MO are** accepting of all types of MAT.
